The decline in HPV vaccine uptake

HPV vaccine uptake rates in Ireland had fallen from an all time high of 87% to approximately 50% in a short space of time

- Working with international experts









Results

Initial indicators show that uptake of the HPV vaccine in Ireland for the first dose of the vaccine for 2017/2018 has reached approximately

70%

An increase of around 20% on the 50% uptake rate from the previous year
