What is the situation in Malta?

Officially there is no patient representation on the Medicines Authority

The Maltese Health Act Cap 528 Laws of Malta Stipulates 2 bodies on which there should be a patient representative or a representative of the Consumer Protection Department :

- •The Council of Health
- •The Advisory Committee of Health Care Benefits

However we were not involved in the selection or the work which happens within these bodies so we followed another path





## Our actions





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
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- The agreement outlines the responsibilities of both entities for closer collaboration especially with regards to the sharing of information and the facilitation of active consultation with MHN as patients' representative.
